



Thank you for purchasing tickets to The Downtown Neighborhoods Association's Mother's Day Historic Home Tour on May 13th from 11am-3pm

Here is some information you might find helpful in advance of the tour:

Parking is available at 6th and Lomas in the Bank of America parking lot and at 17th and Lomas, in the gravel lot and the adjacent paved Manzano Day School parking lot. Street parking is also available and unmetered on Sundays.

The trolley will run on an approximately 20-minute loop and will make multiple on/off stops near houses on the tour. (Of course, you are also welcome to walk between locations to take in all the beauty of our neighborhood!)

If you arrive early and park in the **Manzano** lot, the trolley will make a one-time stop in the lot at **10:45** to take you to Lew Wallace. **If you arrive at the Manzano lot later**, you can catch the trolley at its regular stop on the northeast corner of 17th and Lomas, across from the parking lot, and it will follow the route posted on the trolley sign.

Once you have parked, please proceed to **Lew Wallace Elementary School** on the 7th St side between Fruit and Roma to **check in at the Will-Call table**, where you will be provided with wristbands, programs, and maps. **Please bring your Paypal receipt** or have identification available so we can confirm your purchase. The Will-Call and Ticket tables will be open until 2:00.

If you purchased a **Dine & Discover** ticket for The Cellar, you will receive a distinctive, additional wristband, which will be collected at the restaurant.

Restroom facilities are available at Lew Wallace Elementary, and a Porta Potty will be at 17th and Old Town Road near Tiguex Park.

Food trucks will be parked at Lew Wallace Elementary and on the south side of Tiguex Park and will be selling meals and refreshments prepared by local vendors in affiliation with CNM's Street Food Institute.

If you wish to purchase **additional tickets**, day-of tickets will be available for \$20 at Lew Wallace Elementary.
